 - 2. Describe the business you want to own?
 - 3. What product or service are you planning to sell?
 - 4. What current past or current experiences have prepared you for this venture?
 - 5. How would you finance your business?

3. Two Letters of Recommendation:

- One letter must be from a secondary or post-secondary faculty member having personal knowledge of the Applicant's achievements and potential.
- One letter must be from a current business owner (company letterhead), member of the clergy, local housing authority official, workforce development agency, city/county Department of Economic Development, a Virginia Business Incubator, a Virginia Small Business Development Center, the Virginia Department of Small Business and Supplier Diversity, or the U.S. Small Business Administration.
- 4. Copy of your I.D. (must contain your photo and address); and,
- 5. Letter of Acceptance/Proof of Enrollment in an accredited program of Business Administration, Business Management, or Business with a concentration in Entrepreneurship at a Virginia college or university. Proof of registration in a VHCDC sponsored program.
